EXPLORING THE DENISE AND MARCEL HEIDER COLLECTION

Maison Gribaldi presents an exhibition devoted to contemporary glass design. It ties into a unique story: the donation of the Denise and Marcel Heider collection to Evian Council. This is the first time that some of it has been displayed and it unveils some of the personal choices that make it what it is.

The selected works are joined by pieces by other artists, most of whose names appear in the Heider collection.

The exhibition showcases the soul of the collection, the couple's special bond with glass art and gives us an all-encompassing overview of an exciting field of art with over a hundred unique pieces by some of the greatest artists in the last forty years. It's an opportunity for connoisseurs to revisit the pleasures of the art form and its energy; it's a unique opportunity for newcomers to explore different worlds, imaginations, conceptual approaches and expertise.
